Simple steps to better payments

1. Use a Requisition to quickly request a virtual card.
2. Once approved, a PO is created – Coupa generates a unique one-time credit card number for the authorised supplier and amount.
3. It automatically reconciles the charges and statements back to the PO – so you can keep track of everything.
